## Tim Adams scores a golden hat-trick at 2012 IWC

Tim Adams Wines has won three of the 69 gold medals awarded to Australian wineries at the 2012 International Wine Challenge, the world's largest wine competition.

The Clare Valley winery's gold medals went to Tim Adams 2008 The Aberfeldy Shiraz, Tim Adams 2009 Shiraz and Tim Adams 2010 Semillon.

"It's obviously a sensational result for us, and one of which I'm immensely proud," said Tim Adams.

"To win more than 4 per cent of Australia's gold medals at this prestigious London competition clearly shows that we're punching way beyond our weight.

"And the same goes for the Clare Valley generally. The district won seven gold medals overall — more than 10 per cent of the Australian total.

"That's pretty good for a district that produces less than 4 per cent of Australia's output."

All three of the gold-medal-winning wines are available in Australia, though 2008 The Aberfeldy has been replaced in the trade by the 2009 vintage.
